Intermediate Sailing

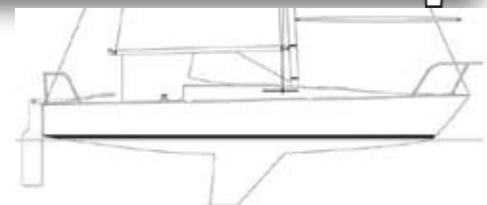
Opti Racing

Each session is comprised of fun and education that includes:

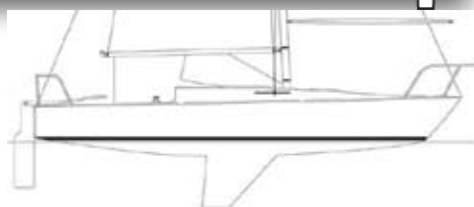
- Big boat day
