Notice of Race

1 RULES

1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing.

2 ADVERTISING

2.1 Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority in accordance with RRS 80.

3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

3.1 The regatta is open to all SBJSA alumni not currently registered in the SBJSA program.

3.2 Current SBJSA racers and staff members are also welcome to participate.

3.3 Family members of alumni are encouraged to participate as crew, but the skipper of each boat must be an alumni

3.4 Eligible participants may enter by completing a registration form which will be available online and at the registration desk. Payment of the entry fee is required prior to the close of registration on race day.

4 FEES

4.1 Required fees are as follows:

4.1.1 Bring your own boat: \$20.00

4.1.2 Per competitor: \$25.00

4.1.2.1 Lasers are on a first come first served basis. If there are not enough Lasers then competitors will be paired up to race in a 420.

4.1.2.2 Laser, Laser Radial, and Laser 4.7 will all be scored as one class. It is the responsibility of the participant to select the type of sail they are most comfortable with.

4.1.2.3 420 competitors will be rotated through boats.

4.1.2.4 Lightning (or other) are bring your own boat.

7 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

7.1 The sailing instructions will be available at the registration table.

8 VENUE

8.1 The sailing area will be near the SBJSA waterfront to facilitate spectating and switching of boats.

9 THE COURSES

9.1 The courses to be sailed may vary in type including: windward-leeward, triangle, roll tack sprints, etc.

9.2 Offset marks and leeward gates may be used.

10 PENALTY SYSTEM

10.1 The sailing instructions will invoke RRS Appendix T, Sections A, B and D.

11 SCORING

11.1 The regatta shall be scored by RRS Appendix A, where all races are scored.

12 PRIZES

12.1 Prizes for 420 & Laser will be awarded for the top 3 finishers in both and Womans divisions.

12.2 Prizes for Lightnings will be top 1 finishers.

12.3 Prizes for Oldest Competitor will be the top 1 finisher.

12.4 Regatta t-shirts available for purchase.

13 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

13.1 Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

14 INSURANCE

14.1 Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance.

14.2 SBJSA members are covered for operation of SBJSA boats.
